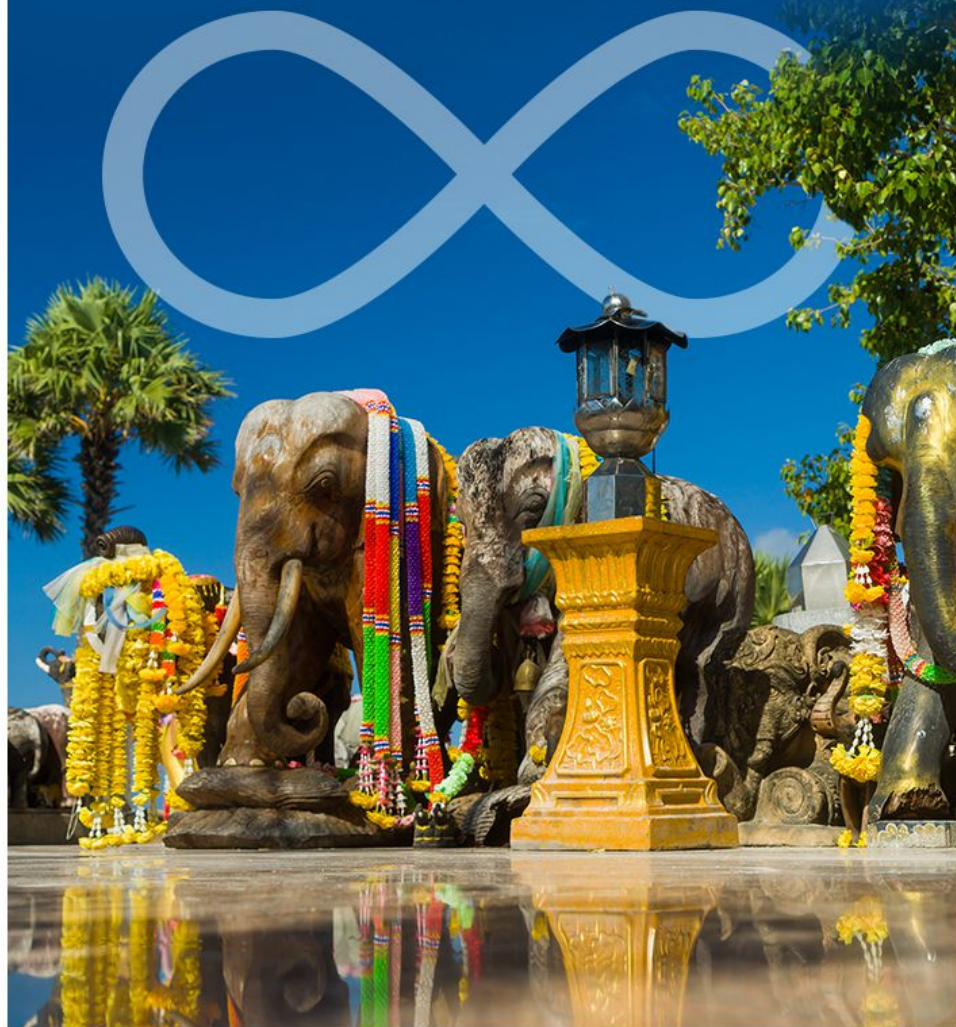

LUMPINI PARK

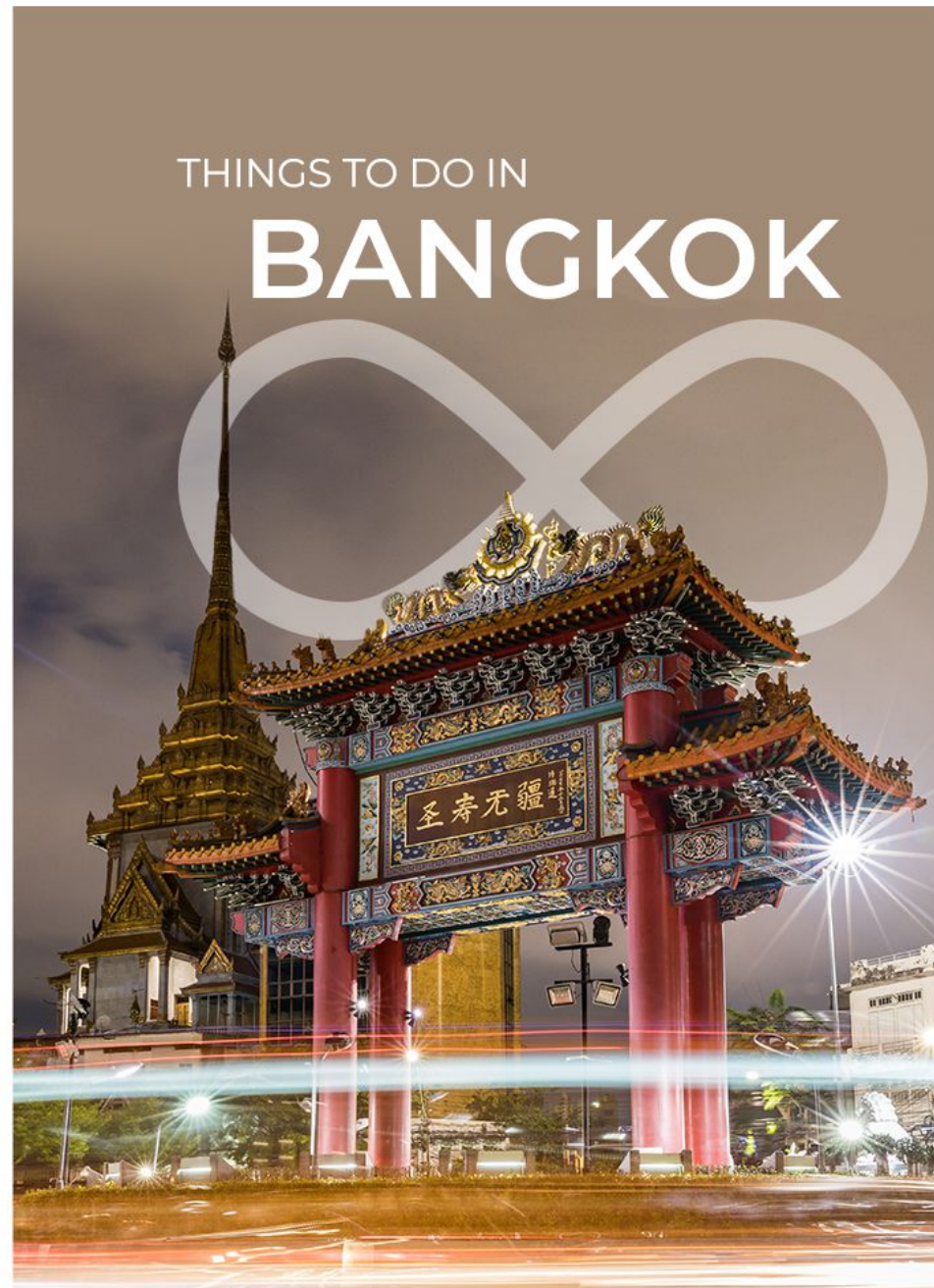

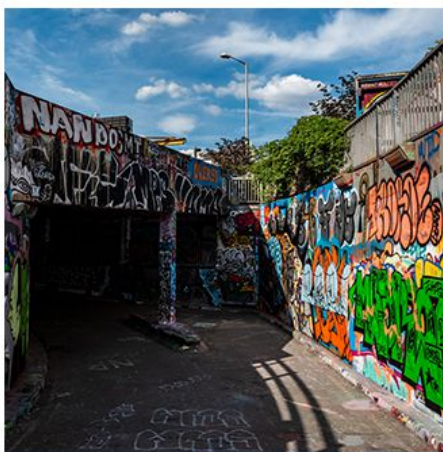

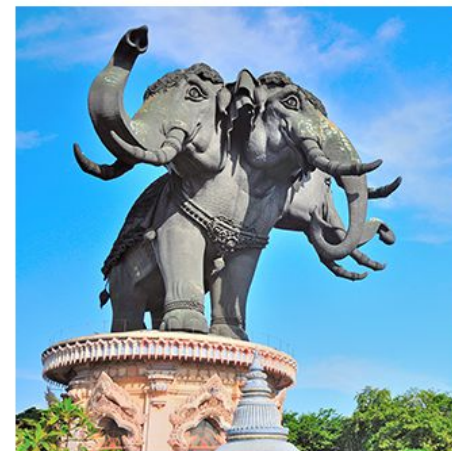
