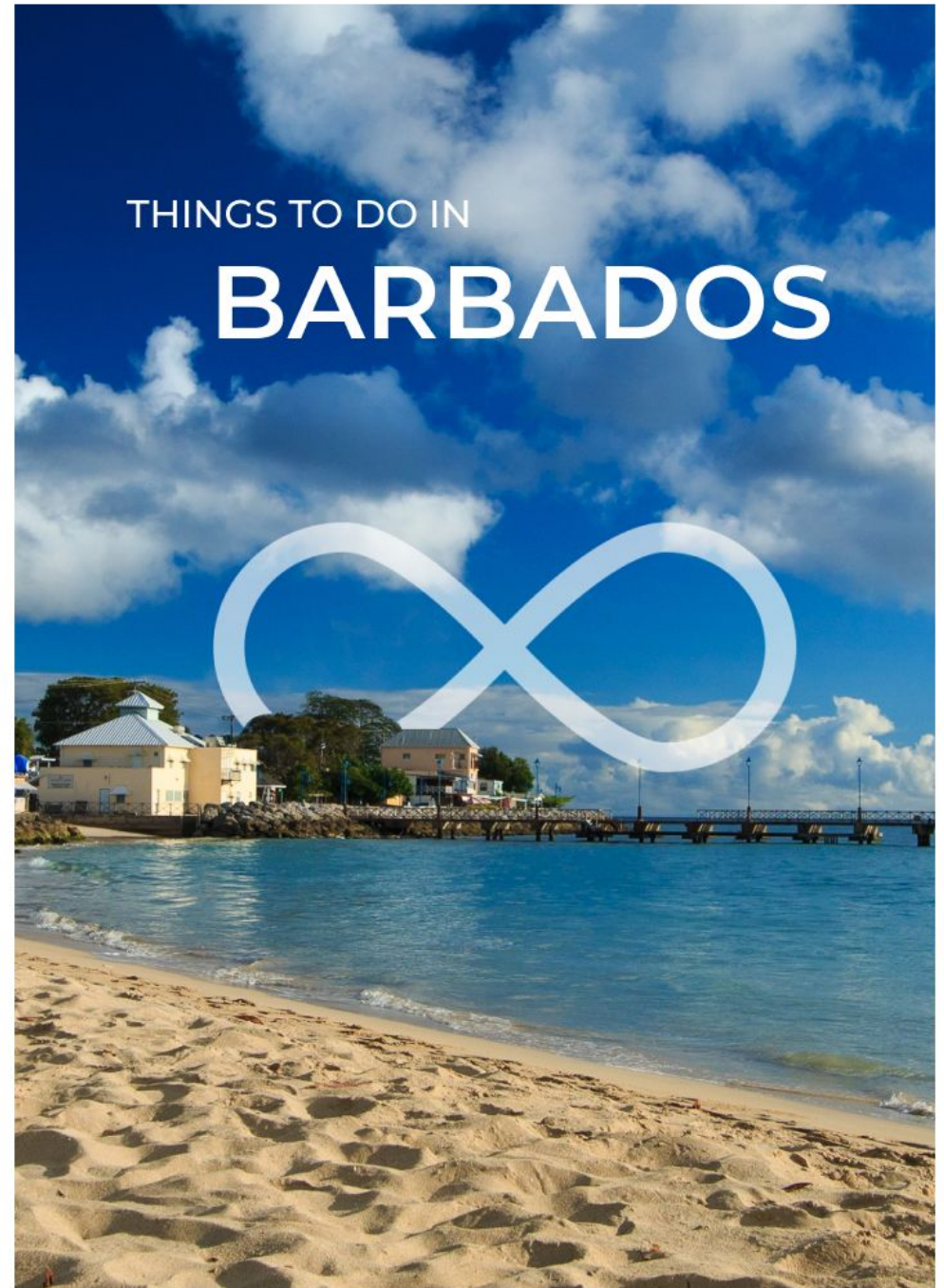
ANDROMEDA BOTANIC GARDENS – A PEACEFUL NATURE ESCAPE

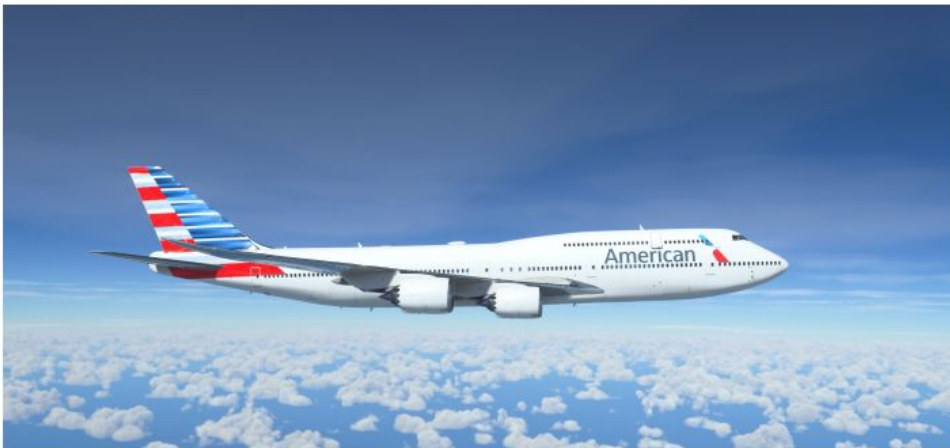
