SAN JOSE

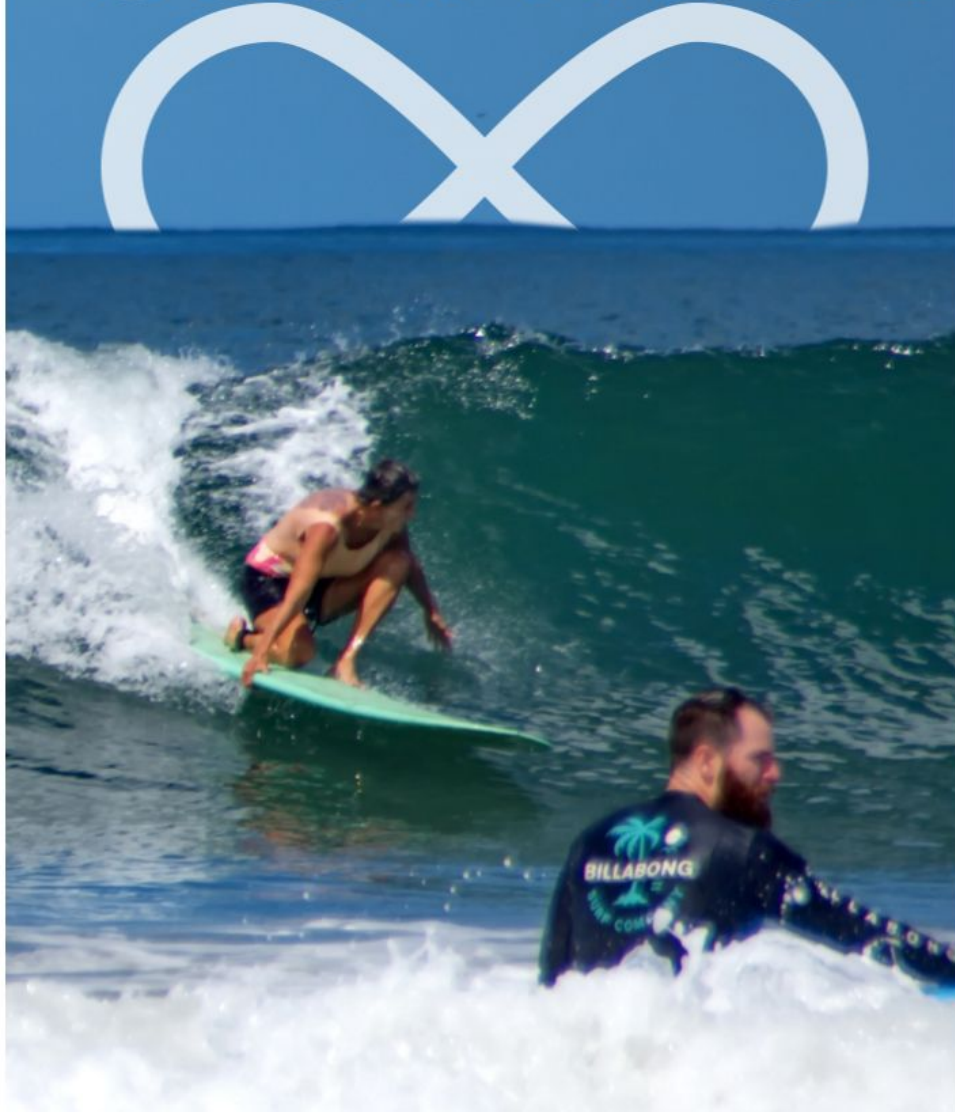
DOMINICAL

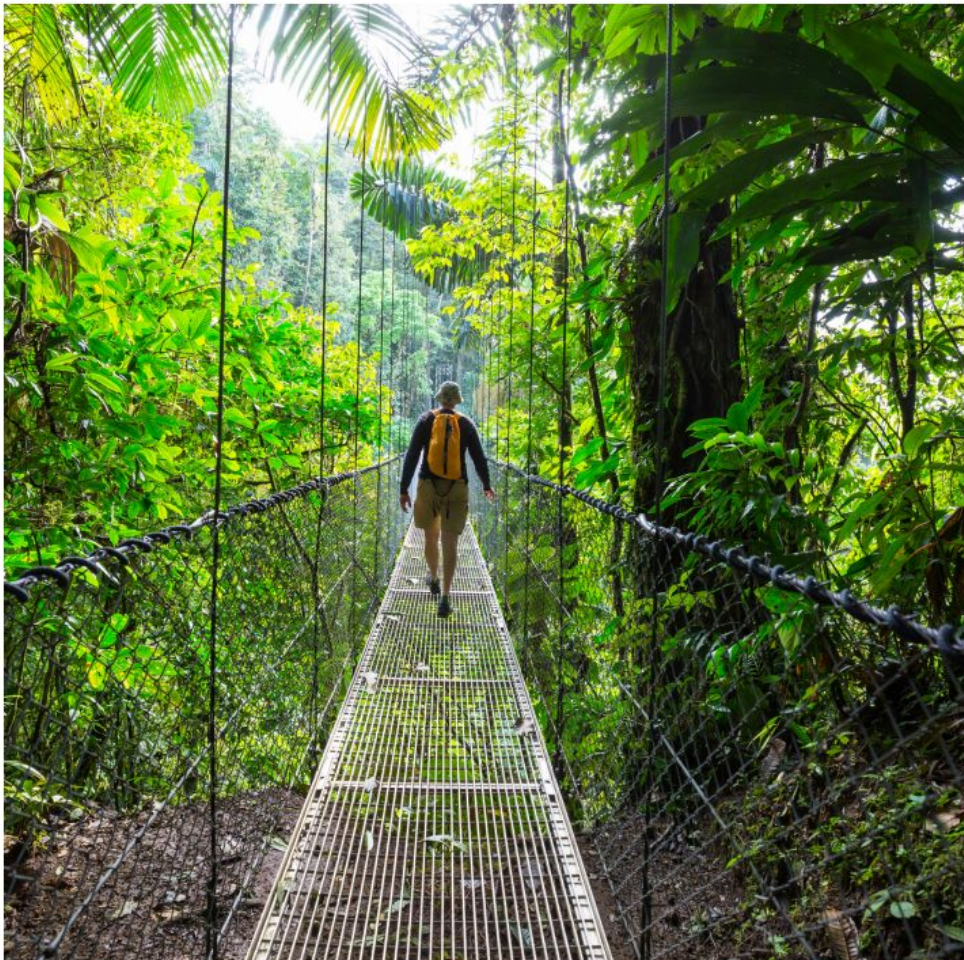

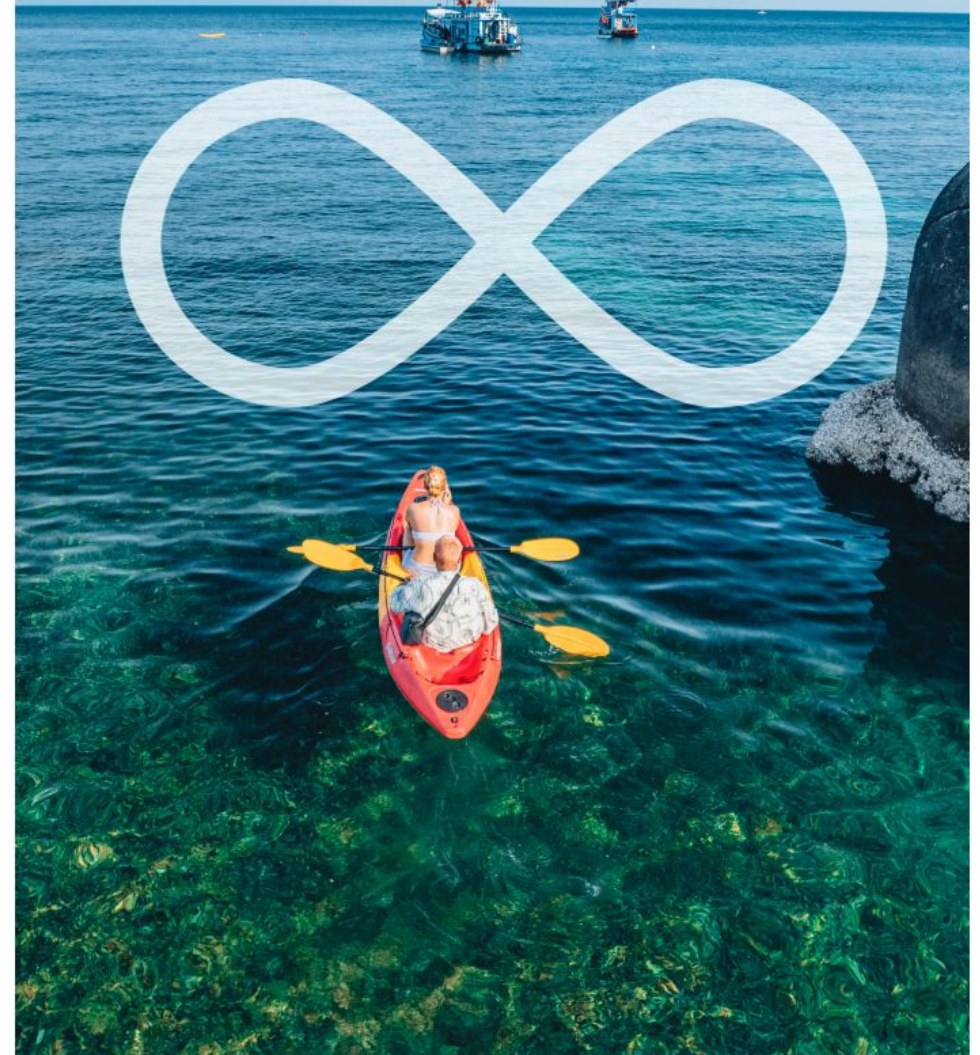
MONTEVERDE
