NAIROBI

CONQUER MOUNT KENYA

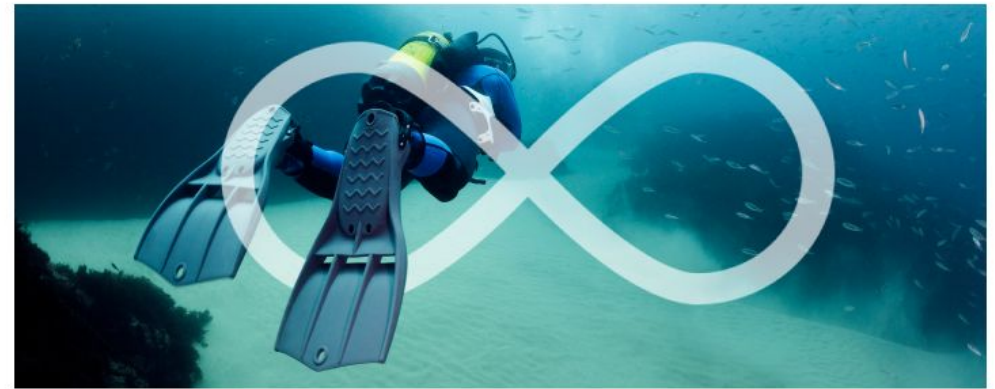
