














Grand Baie

BEL OMBRE NATURE RESERVE

Hop on a guad bike to traverse sugar cane fields, marvel at panoramic views of Domaine de Bel Ombre, and seek out hidden waterfalls, rock pools, and endemic bird species like the Pink Pigeon, Mauritius Black Bulbul, and Mauritius Kestrel. On the edge of the lagoon just off Mauritius' pristine southeastern coast, Île aux Aigrettes offers a vision of the ancient and wild Mauritius that greeted early explorers. Restored as part of a government-backed conservation project, the forest today shelters all manner of endangered bird and other wildlife species – be careful not to trip over a Mauritian giant tortoise!
